

## Selectmen's Work Session August 15, 2022

Those Present – Selectmen, Milinazzo, Redman, and Staples.

### Topics of Discussion

- Discussion on land for sale in Searsmont, which could be a possible location to have the new winter sand/salt building.
- The Selectmen signed the Quit Claim Deed for Autumn Williams.
- Discussion on the Waldo Broadband Corporation. After the discussion, Selectman Redman made a motion to appoint Selectman Peter Milinazzo as the Searsmont Board Member for the Waldo Broadband Corporation with a 3 year term, Selectman Staples seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously.
- Discussion on the tree growth along Pond Road North, the Selectmen are not going to cut the trees at this time.
- Discussion on a Road Paving Bid from Doug Fowler, All States Paving. Selectman Redman would like to prioritize Moody Mountain Road and Thompson Ridge Road as the highest priority. Selectman Redman will contact Doug Fowler for more information pertaining to the bid, the paving, and the chip sealing. Inviting Doug Fowler to the Selectman's Worksession August 22, 2022 at 5:00 p.m.
- Discussion on the Gartley & Dorsky report on Lawry Road. There is not a base to the road.
- Discussion on road work being done on Choate Road.
- Discussion on a bid for painting the Searsmont Library, approximately \$450 - \$500. After the discussion Selectman Redman made a motion to approve the painting of the Library, Selectman Milinazzo seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously.
