Topics of Discussion

- Discussion on the bids received for 3/5 Main Street North. Three bids were received, James Baum - \$10.00, Avary Otis - \$173,500, Jake Boyington - \$211,000. More discussion August 9, 2022.
- Discussion on the winter sand bids. Two bids were discussed, Lucas Construction - \$15.00 a yard, Leeman and Sons - \$14.50 yard 2500 and \$16.50 yard 1500. More discussion August 9, 2022.
- Discussion with Jake Boyington, Appleton Ridge Construction, regarding the road work contract. The five projects will be completed in September.
