Topics of Discussion

- Discussion on Higgins Road North culverts.
- David Marceau, Sexton, discussed the boundary line at Oak Grove has not changed.
- Cenobio Rico will move the Destroyer model to a barn.
- Discussion on the snow plow contract for Stephen Horton, French Road South, \$880.00 for the 2022-2023.
- Discussion on 162 Ghent Road, the house is potentially unsafe. Referring information to William Kelly, Attorney, for advice.
