## February 13, 2023

Those Present – Selectmen, Milinazzo, Redman, and Staples.

The meeting began at 4:30 PM.

### Topics of Discussion

- Discussion on the 63 acre easement wording, to include no mining.
- Discussion with Annette Naegle, Land Management and Trust, on the next steps for review before completing the property sale.
- Discussion with Neil Colburn, Transfer Station Manager, a second dumpster will be considered if the transfer station closes due to inclement weather. Demo Debris Days are planned for May 27, 2023 and August 26, 2023. Pinkerton & Sons will supply the crusher truck.
- Discussion on posting the heavy weight limit signs this week.
- Discussion on the hiring of a Town Tax Collector / Treasurer. Joanna Moulton accepted the off, start date will be February 21, 2023.
- Discussion on hiring Henry Dow, Alternant Animal Control Officer. Selectman Milinazzo made a motion to hire Henry Dow, Alternant Animal Control Officer, starting pay will be \$13.80 per hour when the Animal Control Officer is unavailable, Selectman Redman seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously.
- Discussion on the Town Meeting being held at the Community Building, a date has not been determined at this time.
- Discussion on the Kyocera Copier Lease. Selectman Milinazzo made a motion to extend the copier lease, Selectman Staples seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously.
- Discussion on the State Snow Mobile Reimbursement of \$456.78. Selectman Milinazzo made a motion to split the \$450.00 between the three local snow mobile clubs, the Tri-County, Mountain Goats, and the Ridge Riders clubs, Selectman Staples seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously.
- Discussion on the Midcoast Council, Selectman Staples would like the Selectmen to meet with the Council to hear more on the benefits of being a member.
- Discussion on John Witham filling potholes, posting roads for heavy loads this week.
- Discussion on residents and nonresidents taking salt from the salt shed. Selectmen Staples will mark the chain across the driveway for visibility.

- At 5:45 p.m. Selectman Redman made a motion to enter into executive session under M.R.S.A. §405(6)(C). Selectman Milinazzo seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously.
