

Selectmen's Work Session

February 14, 2022

Those Present – Selectmen, Milinazzo, Redman, and Staples. The meeting began at 4:30 PM.

Topics of Discussion

- Discussion with Neil Colburn, Transfer Station Manager, due to the condition of Crie Road the dumpsters will be located at the Community Building. Crie Road is too soft to drive on, ditching, tree trimming and cutting shoulders this year would help the road condition.
- Michael Sirota discussed pot hole issues, the State roads have more pot holes than town roads.
- Discussion on Peters Road, regular maintenance has not been done in years. Peters Road has not been graded or had gravel added, ditching is not necessary.
- Discussion on 263 Main Street North. The owner has received bids to demolish the building.
- Discussion with Christian Halsted, Planning Board Chair, regarding the Code Enforcement Officer. The Planning Board will add the CEO's initials next to items in the meeting they would like assistance on.
- Discussion with Charles Leroyer regarding the 63 acre property along the river. The discussion included ways to cut trails, informational booths, funding ideas, and other residents with trail experience. The Selectmen will meet again on Wednesday, February 16th to discuss the property in detail.
- Discussion on the refinancing of the Pond Road Fire House. Machias Savings Bank approved lowering the rate on the Fire House loan to 2.99% fixed for the remainder of the loan term. Kathy Hoey informed the Selectmen. The Selectmen accepted the terms and Kathy was to contact the Bank with the approval.
