Topics of Discussion

- Discussion on 170 New England Road, if it forecloses, it would be sold as a fixer-up.
- Discussion on Muzzy Ridge Road 1215 feet at the top, south of Lawry Road needs repair.
- Discussion on transfer station. Neils' son will be helping.
- Discussion on moving the shed from the transfer station to the community building parking lot. The asphalt is breaking up in the community building parking lot.
- Discussion on an interview for the Clerk position, January 12 from 4:30 pm to 5:15 pm.
- Discussion on the Morrow Hill Road ditch, the ditch needs to be cleared.
- Discussion on the culvert on the Borough Road, it has been compromised.
- Discussion on sand shed. The sand/salt shed needs to be secured, and no trespassing signs posted.
- Discussion on a letter from James Murphy, Assessor's Agent, for additional time and costs.
- Discussion on the Ambulance Service billing rates increasing 6.5%.
- Discussion on an invoice for North East Mobile Health Services in the amount of \$600.00.
