

Selectmen's Work Session July 5, 2022

Those Present – Selectmen, Milinazzo, Redman, and Staples.

The meeting began at 4:30 PM.

Topics of Discussion

- Discussion with Billy Kinney and Jake Boyington regarding the Winter Snow Plowing and Sand/Salt procedures. Discussed the new revised routes.
- Discussion on the East Sector will start the Winter Season with usual sand/salt "application" then in the month of January, "application" mixture with transition to more salt and less sand. The Selectmen and Jake will evaluate the results of salt priority application.
- Three inquiries to Steve Lucas as to the lease of the Montville barn for storage of winter sand, with no commitment. Billy Kinney will access Winter sand at the Town storage shed (5 Main Street North). Bid solicitation required Contractors to provide loaders to load sand onto their trucks. Discussion evolved that Jake Boyington, ARC, will provide a loader at Town shed, to load his trucks and Billy Kinney's trucks. Thus eliminating presence of two loaders, and electric demand for second loader. Town will pay ARC \$2,650.00 (1/2 of previous years (\$5,300) paid to Lucas Construction).
- If Billy Kinney secures a storage facility within close proximity to his shop, he will bear any rental cost of facility and loader at the alternative site.
- Discussion on receiving sand and salt. Mixing on site at 5 Main Street North, general consensus concluded that there is sufficient room to execute this operation, co-ordination will be important.
- Discussion on providing a small shed/shelter at the front of the salt/sand shed near Main Street North to provide sand for public use. Discussed utilizing a portion of existing shed, cutting into smaller

structure and moving from back of salt/sand shed to front. Need further evaluation.

- Agreed to meet in August for more discussion.

The meeting ended at 5:30 p.m.
