

Selectmen's Work Session

June 21, 2022

Those Present – Selectmen, Milinazzo, Redman, and Staples.

The meeting began at 4:30 PM.

Also present: Contessa Mancini, Michael Sirota, Karen Withee

Topics of Discussion

- At 4:35 p.m. Selectman Redman made a motion to enter into executive session 1 M.R.S.A. §405(6)(C). Selectman Milinazzo seconded the motion, the vote passed in favor. At 4:51 p.m. the Selectmen returned to the open meeting.
- Discussion with Karen Withee regarding rodents in the Historical Society Barn.
- Discussion with Michael Sirota on the Federal Grant Application for the McLellan property. Michael Sirota will be out of town, Kathy Hoey will submit the application through the cloud process. The Application must be submitted by July 1, 2022 at 5:00 p.m. in a specific order.
- Discussion on an email from Tim Wilson regarding Walker Road and Pond Road South. Selectmen Milinazzo will address the broadband portion of the email. The road questions will be answered by Selectman Redman.
- Discussion on the Crie Road, the road looks good.
- Discussion with Selectman Milinazzo regarding the MIDC (Midcoast Internet Development Corporation). After the discussion Selectman Redman made a motion for Selectman Milinazzo to vote "no" on Searsmont going with MIDC at the June 22, 2022 Broadband Meeting, Selectman Staples seconded the motion. The vote passed in favor to vote "no".
- Discussion on the fuel surcharge from Bolster's Trash, for the cardboard recycling.
- Discussion on the storage of the winter sand, salt, and sand salt mix. The 5 Main Street North building has large cracks and spaces on the building, consideration of hydraulic cement as a filler to prevent the interior from being so wet. More information is necessary.
- Selectman Redman measured Morrow Hill Road for repairs, 160' x 18' with 1 culvert needing replacement. Recommendation; excavate 160 lf x 18" wide road to depth of approximately 24". Construct new road base and pave. Replace 1 existing culvert, ditching as necessary along new road base.
- Selectman Redman assessed West Appleton Road, repairs include a culvert 16" x 24', cold patch for potholes and ditching will be necessary.

- Selectman Redman assessed Thompson Ridge Road, possible to pave 300' x 20' from the town line to the hill, to fill 3-4 potholes by mailbox 198, 93, and cmp pole 9 with a culvert to replace 16" x 42'.
- Selectman Redman will put together a bid specification for the Selectmen to review at the June 27, 2022 worksession.
- Selectman Redman will contact Gartley & Dorskey for an update on Lawry Road.
- Discussion on chip sealing Moody Mountain, and Ghent Roads. Selectman Redman will contact Doug at All States Paving for more information.
- Discussion on trees growing along the sides of the road. Selectman Redman noticed an excavator looking machine on tracks with one of the tree companies. More information is necessary.
- Discussion on the orange flags marking cable and wires buried underground where ditching is planned.
- At 6:12 p.m. Selectman Redman made a motion to enter into executive session 22 M.R.S.A. §4306. Selectman Milinazzo seconded the motion, the vote passed in favor. At 6:15 p.m. the Selectmen returned to the open meeting.
- Discussion on sending a letter denying a Hardship Application regarding a Rescue bill.

The meeting ended at 5:27 p.m.
