### Topics of Discussion

- Discussion on Employment Practice Liability Insurance, Loss of Data Computer Insurance, Government Declared Cyber Attacks Insurance. Selectman Redman will receive quotes from Kyes Insurance, to determine necessity.
- Discussion on Town Road residential driveways, Frank Therio, CEO approves.
- Discussion on Waldo County Sheriff contacting Selectman Staples regarding grass in the roadway. Selectmen agree, Sheriff should be responsible for this issue.
- Discussion on Broadband updates with MidCoast Internet Development. A decision is necessary by June 30<sup>th</sup> to participate, so GWI can start engineering process.
- Discussion on paving bids, season is passing. Base work needs to be completed prior to paving. 100 lineal feet on Morrow Hill Road and Borough Road. The Selectmen will mark the roads and prepare the bid package.
- Discussion on ditching and culvert work on West Appleton Road. Selectman Milinazzo will mark the location.
- Discussion on Centerline marking Muzzy Ridge Road.
- Discussion on the Winter Snow Plow Contract Bid Package. Having three resources, salt, sand, and salt/sand mix. There will be five routes.
- Discussion on the diesel fuel allowance, years past the rate was \$5.00 per gallon, the contract will be raised to \$7.00 per gallon.
- Discussion on Special Town Meeting, scheduled for June 7, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.
- Discussion with Michael Sirota, the McLellan property Federal Grant Application Draft will be reviewed. Modifications were noted and corrected.
- Discussion with J-Sun Bailey on the current status of the Broadband Committee.
