Topics of Discussion

- Discussion on the Pubic Budget Meeting scheduled for Tuesday, March 21, 2023 at 6:00 p.m.
- Discussion with Adi Philson, Mid Coast Council of Governments, the benefits of becoming a member. The cost is \$1.25 per resident, approximately \$1.688.00 annually. More information is necessary before a decision is made.
- Discussion on the Opioid Settlement, money will be sent to Waldo County.
- Discussion on the Notice of Decision, from James Murphy, Assessors Agent. After the discussion, Selectman Staples made a motion to accept the Notice of Decision as it is written, Selectman Milinazzo seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously.
- Discussion on the pot holes and crumbling road base, chip sealing and overlay to be done in the spring. Ghent Road and Thompson Ridge Road will need attention.
- Discussion on the Revenue Budget, an increase on the transfer station trash bag stickers. After the discussion, Selectman Milinazzo made a motion to increase the sticker prices from \$8.00 a sheet to \$10.00 a sheet (5 orange stickers or 10 blue/green stickers).
- At 5:45 p.m. Selectman Redman made a motion to enter into executive session M.R.S.A. §4506 (6)(d) to discuss the personnel benefits, Selectman Milinazzo seconded the motion. All votes were unanimous. At 6:17 the Selectmen returned to the regular meeting.
