Topics of Discussion

- Discussion on 3 Main Street. The Selectmen are not considering making a decision tonight. Tabled for May 10, 2022 Selectmen Meeting.
- Discussion on TRIO Web base, \$3,000.00, not necessary at this time.
- Discussion on heavy loads postings. The roads are no longer posted, Selectman Milinazzo will remove the posting from Lime Kiln Road.
- Discussion on the Maine for Land Meeting, Selectman Redman has not received an email confirming a date.
- Discussion with Cassandra Inman. Cassandra would like the opportunity to advance with the Town of Searsmont, to a full time position. Tabled for more information.
- Discussion on the Planning Board Comprehensive Plan. Maine requires a new plan every ten years, 2023 the Searsmont Plan is due.
