

Selectmen's Work Session October 31, 2022

Those Present – Selectmen, Milinazzo, Redman, Staples

The meeting began at 4:30 PM.

Topics of Discussion

- Discussion on the bushes and trees around the Community Building. Selectman Milinazzo made a motion to have Dean Anderson, Landscaper, to trim the bushes and trees at the Community Building, Selectman Redman seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously.
- Gartley & Dorskey submitted a bid of \$5,200.00 to survey the McLellan property. Selectman Milinazzo made a motion to pay Gartley & Dorskey \$5,200.00 to survey the 63 acre parcel, Selectman Redman seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously.
- Selectman Redman made a motion to have Fuller Construction put one inch minus on Walker Road, Selectman Milinazzo seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously.
- Discussion on the road budget, after the additional Morrow Hill Road work, the budget may be over.
- Discussion on the price of diesel fuel for the snow plow drivers. The Selectmen will use the average of Waldo County for the price of diesel.
- Discussion on the scout room closet, the Boy and Girl Scouts are not active at this time.
- Discussion on posting the Clerk position. Selectman Milinazzo will put the ad together to post as soon as possible.
- Discussion on the RFP for an Auditor.
- Discussion on the Searsmont Scholarship Donation, Kathy Hoey would like the Selectmen to disperse \$500.00 towards the award and \$500.00 towards the principle. Selectman Milinazzo made a motion to split the \$1,000.00 donation as \$500.00 towards the yearly recipient award and \$500.00 towards the principle to earn interest, Selectman Redman seconded the motion. The vote passed unanimously.
- Discussion on patching the blacktop on Borough Road and Morrow Hill Road. Selectman Staples contacted Dave, Discount Paving, to do a course base binder on Morrow Hill Road approximately 18" x 160", and Borough Road approximately 16" x 300". Discount paving will give Selectman Staples an estimate.

- Selectman Staples spoke with Andrew Russo, Main Street North. Selectmen will continue with the law suit.
- Discussion on the brush along Appleton Ridge Road. John Witham will cut the brush before it snows.
