### Topics of Discussion

- Discussion on Selectman Milinazzo contacting Chris Corson, Come Spring Business Park, about two acres next to the Fire Station property.
- The Republican Journal has a notice to Searsmont Residents with 5 acres or more, as possible site for the salt/sand building.
- Discussion with Michelle Secotte and Robert Boynton, residents, about the culvert at 996 Moody Mountain Road. The Town Ordinance for Culvert Replacement, Selectman Redman will contact William Kelly, Attorney, for clarification. Selectmen Redman should have an answer by Tuesday, October 11, 2022.

- Discussion with Jake Boyington, regarding the road work on West Appleton Road, Magog Road, Pond Road South, and Morrow Hill Road.
- Discussion on grading the dirt roads which will include Magog Road, Walker Road, Fowles Road, Crie Road, Lime Kiln Road, and Peters Road. Selectman Staples will check on Diamond Road, French Road, and Morrow Hill Road.
- The Selectmen will close Ripley Road and Rugby Road to winter maintenance.
- Selectman Redman is working on the Snow Plow Contracts.
