You are invited to bid on the following project: Winter Rd Maintenance-Fire Station, Community Building, Bridge Sidewalk 2025/2026

Description; **Fire Station:** Plow, shovel, and salt/sand as required, the “Fire Station” located at 1 Pond Rd South, prior to servicing any private or other public properties. Remove snow and ice from the entrance of each overhead door and all entry doors (by shoveling or other means), salt or sand as needed, and as directed by the Selectmen and/or Fire Chief, and in accordance with the snow removal law. Remove the snow on the above-described location, leaving as little buildup as possible. If extreme conditions occur, the Municipal Officers will arrange for additional snow removal equipment. Locate plow truck and operator within the boundaries of the Town of Searsmont. Equipment shall be adequate and satisfactory for the work to be performed, properly maintained to efficiently accomplish the winter maintenance work. The town will provide the sand and salt.

Community Building

Remove snow (shovel or snow blower at contractors’ option) at: main walk entrance to the Community Building, Lower level to the Community Building, clear snow at steps of landings of emergency exists (2), apply sand/salt (provided by the town) as needed to main walk entrance to the Community Building.

Bridge sidewalk at Main St South

Remove snow (shovel or snowblower at contractors’ option) at bridge sidewalk, on a requested basis. If snowplow contractor is unable to plow snow from sidewalk, selectmen will notify this contractor to remove snow. If snow becomes frozen, resulting in difficult conditions to shovel the municipal officers will arrange snow removal equipment. Contractor must wear proper reflective clothing or vest while performing snow removal.

All bids must be submitted to the Town Office in a sealed envelope clearly marked "Winter Road Maintenance Fire Station, Community Building, Bridge Sidewalk-Bid"

Bid Closing Date: May 15th, 1pm

Bid Awarding Date: May 19th, 2025

Successful Bidder is acting as an independent contractor, and not an employee or agent of the town. Successful bidder is solely responsible for complying with all the State and Federal laws.

The contractor must keep all intersections clear and plow back to allow adequate visibility upon entering or exiting. The contractor will plow so called slush off the roads before it freezes to roadways or at the discretion of the Towns Representatives.

Terms and Conditions:

1. Contractor will supply all necessary equipment and manpower.

The Selectmen have the right to accept or reject any or all bids, and resubmit for bids if necessary. Project may be stopped or terminated if the material does not meet specifications.
