

Selectmen's Meeting Minutes

November 25th, 2024

1. Meeting Called to Order at 4:34pm
2. Public Comments
 - a. Charlie LeRoy shared that the bridge for the trail has been completed. The trail has been blazed all the way around with blue paint. A couple of directional arrows need to be put up, but the trail is open and ready for use. The trail will be extended to begin in the mowed field to the right of the entrance to the town office, for more visibility and easier access. Kiosk is getting finalized and signs for federal side of kiosk have been ordered.
 - b. Charlie brought up a concern of multiple unregistered vehicles accumulating and a couch in the right of way at 1228 Moody Mtn Rd. Selectman Redman is going to send Walter Wetmore over to inspect this property. Gail Gary-Cox is going to research junkyard and automobile graveyard ordinances. A letter will need to be written to move the couch from the town's right of way.
 - c. Parking in the right of way at the end of Moody Mtn Rd, Neeley Sweet, will need a letter informing her that parking is not permitted in the towns right of way.
 - d. Selectman Redman reported that there are multiple vehicles being parked in the right of way on Muzzy Ridge Rd for multiple days for trash removal, starting on Sunday and extending into Wednesday, creating a hazard. The Selectmen decided a letter needs to be written to the residents of this address, to make other arrangements to clear the way for trash removal that will not create a hazard or interfere with the right of way.
3. Selectmen's Comments
 - a. John Withum will be putting signs up when the additional sign is delivered for Chassie Lane. The bridge will get cleaned up. John will fill in dip on

Muzzy Ridge Rd. with coal patch. Gail Gary-Cox will check with Peter Coughlin regarding stop signs at end of Muzzy Ridge Rd and Moody Mtn Rd and see if the state owns those or the town. If the state owns them, can we get Moody Mtn Rd. replaced, and Muzzy Ridge Rd. moved forward and add the town road above.

- b. Selectman Redman spoke with Donald Fuller. Donald will be laying gravel on French Rd North and yolk rake it out, Wed, Thurs. or Friday. Next week, Donald will do the culvert on Walker Rd.
4. Modifications to the Agenda-Only modification is to strike executive session and item 8 will be added as item 7a under New Business.
5. Approval of the Minutes for November 18th, 2024
Selectman Staples made a motion to approve the minutes with one grammar correction in spelling. Selectman Redman seconded the motion. Unanimous.
6. Old Business
 - a. Moody Mtn Rd. looks good where F.C. Work finished leveling shoulder work.
 - b. French Rd South needs some work. Selectman Redman is going to talk to Donald about taking care of this.
 - c. There is a tire that needs to be packed with rock that Donald Fuller knows about.
7. New Business
 - a. Appointment of Office, Andrew Schindel as General Assistance Administrator Pursuant to 22 M.R.S.A. §4302. Selectman Redman made a motion to appoint Andrew Schindel. Selectman Staples seconded the motion. Unanimous.
