PERMITS

Applications for the following permits can be obtained from the town office during normal office hours:

- **Concealed weapon permit**
- **Building permit**
- **Plumbing permits**
- **Driveway/Entrance permits**

It is recommended that you review the requirements for building and plumbing permits with the Code Enforcement Officer (CEO) or the License Plumbing Inspector (LPI), as well as any questions you have about the application or application process. Please call the CEO or the LPI at the town office to arrange an appointment.

Burn permits can be obtained at no charge on line at wardensreport.com or the Fire Warden. Permits may be restricted at the discretion of the Fire Warden.

DOG LICENSES

Owners or keepers (caring for a dog that they do not own) must license dogs that have been in their care for more than 10 days and are over 6 months of age. A current rabies vaccination certificate is required for registration, as well as proof of neuter/spay, if applicable.

Dog licenses are due for the next calendar year	December 31
Grace period for dog licenses	No fine January 1-31
Late registration fine	\$15.00 fine per dog* starting February 1
After Animal Control Officer contact	\$25.00 fine per dog* about Mid-March

**These are state mandated fines and are not negotiable*

MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION

New vehicle registration requires: New title application & sales tax form from the dealer, proof of insurance, and the window sticker from the car

Used vehicle new registration requires: Properly signed title (if vehicle less than 15 years old) showing transfer of ownership, bill of sale (include VIN #, mileage, purchase price, and signatures of buyer and seller), and proof of insurance.

Reregistration of vehicle requires: Proof of insurance, current mileage.

Registration Transfer requires: Yellow registration from your old car. *Do not give this to the dealer or purchaser when you trade in or sell your old car.*

For SR-22 registrants or NEW Vanity plates: Excise tax is first paid at the town office, then the registration must be completed at a Bureau of Motor Vehicles Branch Office. Availability of a vanity plate can be checked online at <http://www.maine.gov/sos/bmv/>

RECREATIONAL VEHICLE REGISTRATIONS

New registrations of a new vehicle require a sales tax form from the dealer.

For new registrations of a used vehicle, a bill of sale is required, with VIN#.

Used boats and snowmobiles: The previous Maine registration number is also needed. Excise is computed on boat's age, length, and engine horsepower. IFW fees are based on the horsepower of the motor. ALL BOAT REGISTRATIONS EXPIRE DEC 31.

Lake protection Milfoil stickers are required for fresh-water boats available at Town Office.

HUNTING/FISHING LICENSES

New Residents: Must be a resident of Maine for at least 3 months; vehicle registration and Driver license must be Maine's

New and renewals: Must bring evidence of previous hunting or archery license OR a Safe Hunter Course card.

TRASH BAGS: \$10.00/5 large bags--\$10.00/10 kitchen size, sold at the Transfer Station or Town Office. Only Town-issued bags will be accepted for disposal.

DEMO DEBRIS DAYS: To dispose of furniture, carpets, household electronics (no computers or TV's), and construction debris. Scheduled 2-3 xs during warm weather months. Watch for posters with schedule and fees.

SEARSMONT RECYCLING GUIDE

TO RECYCLE THESE ITEMS

Newspaper	Place in newspaper container. Do not put string or brown bags into container.
Magazines, catalogues, phone books	Place mixed paper in container.
Tin & Aluminum cans	Clean and place in the plastic bins. Labels may be left on.
Cardboard	Corrugated cardboard must flatten. Place in cardboard container. No boxboard. Please remember to remove all Styrofoam or other packing material.
